CALLS: Please report to the starting line fifteen minutes before your race begins.

TEAM SCORING: Men's and Women's Varsity teams will be allowed 10 runners. Team scores will be computed by totaling the top five runners' finish positions. The 6th and 7th runners will count as pushers. Runners 8-10 will not be figured into the team scores but will be given official times. Junior Varsity teams will be allowed maximum of 10 runners entries. Scoring will be the same as with the varsity races.

- HIGH SCHOOL INFO:** Oconee County High School will co-host the Bulldog Stampede. All high schools competing must be members of the Georgia High School Athletic Association. The Bulldog Stampede is sanctioned by the GHSA. - COURSE:** All grass, rolling hills, and well-marked with extremely good footing
- COURSE INSPECTION:** The course will be available for inspection on Friday, September 21 from 3 pm to 6 pm.
- FINISH LINE:** Please have your runners run all the way through the chute. *The chute area will be restricted to meet officials only.* All runners must wear their assigned numbers on the front of their singlet. A tear-off label is attached to each number. Please do not pin the tear-off label. This label will be removed at the scoring table.
- PACKET PICK-UP/ NUMBERS:** Packets may be picked up Saturday morning starting at 6 am outside the main clubhouse at the golf course.
- PARKING:** Overflow and buses park at the Soccer/Softball Complex on South Milledge Avenue. A shuttle bus to & from the course will be provided. Detailed information about shuttle buses and parking will be posted to www.georgiadogs.com.
- AWARDS:** Awards will be given to the top 15 individuals and 1st & 2nd place teams in all divisions. An awards presentation will be held after each race.
