

## Event Procedures

Please read/distribute/share with your team at your practice before the meet or bus ride to the event.

- 1) All events will be called twice, 5 minutes between each calling. The opposite field events will be called 10 minutes after completion of the starting field event. The meet starts at 10:00 am for both field and track events.
- 2) Running events will check in at the Clerk's Table. Field Events will check in at their event station.
- 3) All lane numbers go on the left leg/hip. Please make sure they can be seen and not covered by your uniform.
- 4) All athletes need to stay off the track/turf unless you are checking in or actively participating in your event. We are hoping to have a warm-up area for runners after they check in on the turf.
- 5) Do not cross the track/turf for any reason, (except to participate on the track) to walk to events not on the track, bathroom, snack bar, etc., please stay outside the fence. There will be signs pointing you in the proper directions.
- 6) The only two entrances to the track will be a small gate by the softball field (Tent City) and a large gate by the start of the Javelin.
- 7) After the race, have your athletes return to the finish line. From here they can see their time on the race clock if they want to know how they did. Do not ask the table for scores.
- 8) Do not jump any fence, either temporary or fixed.
- 9) Bathrooms are in the shed behind the bleachers.

Please share the following with your bus drivers.

- 1) All busses will be parked at the middle school. From the middle school, people can walk to downtown (there is no bus parking downtown) or up to the high school.
