- *Entries are \$40 per athlete up to 10 athletes (\$400 max per gender)*
- **THIS IS AN ENTRY FEE, NOT A COMPETITION FEE**—There are no refunds for non-accepted entries, scratches or no-show athletes.
- *Any late additions will be \$60 per event, no max*

Final Scratches: Final additions and scratches should be made by noon Wednesday May 8th

Facilities: 400 meter Mondo X surface (8 lanes turn / 8 lanes straight) Concrete throwing circles, Javelin is a Mondo runway - 1/4 spikes only. Only **1/4 inch Pyramid spikes** will be permitted. **Spikes will be checked!**

Weigh-ins: Will take place at the Fairgrounds for all throwing events. Weigh-Ins will close when warm ups for the event start.

Parking: Team drop off will be on the east side of Finnie Stadium on Maple Ave. Buses can park on Maple Ave or use the Fairground parking lot off of East Center St. (~0.5 mile)

Meet Results: Fully automatic timing system by wingmantiming.com. Results will be available online at BWyellowjackets.com Live Results will be available online at wingmantiming.com

WARM-UP AREA: We will be utilizing the upper turf practice field for warm ups. We will have extra blocks and hurdles located on the upper field. The infield can get very crowded during the meet so for safety we would like to prevent any potential collisions. We would like to keep the hurdles in their respective spots near their marks inside the stadium.

Team Camps: Team camps will be in the backstretch side bleachers. Please do not set up any tents on the infield or on the homestretch bleachers.

Starting Heights: The head field judge will establish the starting heights based on the progression that best fits gaining entrance into National Championships.

- Pole vault starting heights will not go lower than 10' for women and 13' for men

Preferred Lanes: Lane assignments will be based on entries. Heats will be at the discretion of the meet director to give each heat the best chance to run fast.

- 4,5,3,6,7,2,8,1 for the 100m and 100/110m hurdles.
- 200 & 400m Dashes 4,5,6,7,3,8,2,1. We will not run lane 1 or 2 for the 200 and 400m, unless requested.
