General Entry Procedures: The only method of entering the Open Competitions at NAU is online through www.directathletics.com. All Indoor Competitions will be open to ALL NCAA DIVISION I Programs. Other interested collegiate teams, unattached athletes, NAU students, or high school athletes should contact Alan Dunson (alan.dunson@nau.edu) to discuss possible entry. There is no entry fee for NAU students with a valid student ID card. Payment for both individuals and collegiate teams will only be accepted online after registering. A performance list will be published upon the close of entries and if you have not submitted payment by the entry deadline then entries will not show up in the published performance list. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN ONCE ENTRY FEE IS ACCEPTED.

Entry Standards: Once posted, please review 2020 entry standards for the Mountain T's Invitational & NAU Tune-Up meets. If your athlete has met the suggested standard from January 2018 – present, he/she will be accepted. We will accept entries beyond the standards to fill the fields. Field sizes for ALL EVENTS will be controlled in order to complete the meet within the proposed time schedule. That may mean that we may only be able to accept a certain number of athletes in a particular set of events. ALL ENTRIES are at the discretion of the meet management staff.

Seeding and Entry Notes – TFRS marks from January 2018- present will be the primary guide for proper seeding. Placement in heats/flights will be at the discretion of the meet management staff. If an athlete does not have a TFRS mark, a verified performance must be submitted via email. Performances that cannot be verified will be moved to slower sections or subject to non-acceptance into the meet. It is the responsibility of the coach to submit necessary performances as prescribed. If you have any additional seeding notes (IE-better 1500 than mile time; collegiate freshman, etc.) please email Alan Dunson (alan.dunson@nau.edu) BEFORE CLOSE OF ENTRIES. All entries will be considered final at the close of entries.

Entry Fee Structure – Entry fees are \$350/gender. Team and Individual Entries are payable ONLINE ONLY. Schools with 14 or more athletes are considered to have a team. Teams with less than 14 athletes will pay \$25 per athlete. ALL ENTRY FEES MUST BE PAID ON DIRECTATHLETICS.COM PRIOR TO CLOSE OF ENTRIES. Entry fees will not be refunded.

Packets/Heat Sheets/Results: Accepted entries, performance lists, and heat sheets will be posted on www.nauathletics.com. -Accepted entries and Performance lists will be posted by 6:00pm after scratch deadline. -Heat sheets will be posted by Noon on the day of the meet. -Heat sheets will be provided in meet packets. Packets will be available at the finish line beginning one hour before the start of competition. Schedule updates will be posted on www.nauathletics.com and will be provided at the finish line during the pre meet warm up times. Heats and Flights are subject to change based on late scratches. Height progressions for the meets will be provided after close of entries. **IMPORTANT STRAIGHTAWAY RACE NOTES REGARDING FINALS:** 16 Qualifiers will advance for a two heat final (Unattached/Elite, Collegiate) at Friday Night Duals Meet & Lumberjack Team Challenge, whereas 8 Qualifiers will advance for a single heat final (featuring all Unattached/Elite/Collegiate) at Mountain T's Invitational, and finally 8 Qualifiers will advance for a single heat (Collegiate only) at NAU Tune-Up.

Check-In/Warm-Up/Team Camps: The location for check-in will be at the bottom of the elevator on the south-east side of Skydome. Participants may check in as early as desired, but no later than 30' prior to the start of the race, with the report time being no later than 15' prior to the start of the race. Participants may warm up on the concourse area of the Skydome, or on the backstretch during the short sprints and hurdles. Throwers may only warm up in the throws area. No athletes are allowed to be on the track during oval races.
