Rules: NEW for 2022- We have collaborated with leagues across the state to standardize events, but will

continue to follow a modified version of the Tri County League/Federation rules overall. All throwing and relay implements will be provided- you may bring your own but they will need to

pass inspection to be used.

Awards: No team scoring. Medals to top-3 and ribbons for next 3 athletes in each event. Trophy for Boy and

Girl Most Outstanding Athlete.

meet.

Qualifying

This meet is open to all <u>school-sponsored</u> programs and athletes in grades 5-8. <u>Top-2 finishers from each Individual event and 2-4 for each Relay event from each league championship meet <u>automatically qualify</u>. If any of the top 2 athletes or relay teams cannot attend, the next best finishers of the top-6 that can attend are eligible to enter. <u>Max of 2 of the top-6 finishers per league championship automatically qualify.</u> Please do not enter your athletes until you have marks from the league meet.</u>

Additionally, <u>athletes from schools that are not in a recognized league</u> can qualify by achieving performance standards during the season (see table below).

Additionally, all schools can enter near-miss athletes that didn't auto qualify (league meet or auto-qualifying standards) but have competitive marks. Athletes that do not have school programs may be able to participate with their school's permission- please email coachjustinplatt@gmail.com to discuss.

<u>Register using athlete's BEST valid marks from the current season</u>, and not necessarily marks from the league championship. Please try to ensure accurate entries. If an athlete had 1 outlier that was much better than others and maybe not accurate please consider not using it.

Depending on the number registered in each event limits may be imposed to ensure timely running of the meet. Additional athletes will be selected to fill fields based on performance.

Instructions for Registering for Meet in Direct Athletics (DA)

All schools must use <u>www.directathletics.com</u> to enter the meet after . There is NO CHARGE for using this website. The entry process consists of two parts:

- 1. You must first update your rosters on Direct Athletics or, if you do not have an existing Team in Direct Athletics, create your Team and put in your rosters. Make sure you create a girls team for the girls and boys team for boys.
- 2. In DA go to MEET SCHEDULE, click on the green register bar for the NH Middle Schools Meet of Champions, and enter each athlete into the meet. You must do this for both boys and girls separately. If you do not see the meet on your DA schedule, you need to contact Justin Platt coachjustinplatt@gmail.com with the DA school team name so that your team can be "invited" to the meet. This step is not automated and may take several hours. When your team has been invited you will receive an email confirming.

If you are a new coach to your school you will either have to get the user name and password for the account from the previous coach, or create a new account for yourself.

Instructions for Setting Up Team in Direct Athletics

- 1. Go to www.DirectAthletics.com
- 2. On the top menu bar click on: Sign Up
- 3. Choose Team Account
- 4. Fill in the information:
 - Email address
 - Sport = Track and Field
 - Team Type = Middle School/Junior High/Elementary
 - State = New Hampshire
 - Country = United States
 - Click the Submit button
- 5. Fill in the information on the form completely and click Submit. Note that you'll have to do this procedure twice if you are coaching both boys and girls teams. Leave the Meets section blank.
- 6. Once you get your Team established,
 - Follow the prompts to add your athletes and make sure that you click the Submit button as this is what actually saves each athlete to the database.
 - Send an e-mail to <u>coachjustinplatt@gmail.com</u> with the EXACT SCHOOL NAME that you registered under so that your team can be "invited" to the meet. This step is not automated and may take several hours. When your team has been invited you will receive an email confirming.
- 7. When you have all your athletes in your rosters and have been invited to the meet, click on MEET SCHEDULE, click on the green register bar for the NH Middle Schools Meet of Champions, and enter each athletes into the meet. You must do this for both boys and girls separately. If you don't do this step, your kids will not be entered into the meet.
- 8. For all entries, they MUST include a Time/Mark and the meet and date the mark was set. Any entries without a valid mark and meet will be questioned and potentially deleted.
