Qualification & Registration

[Qualification standards](#) must be achieved during the school season (with a few exceptions). Once results are posted on MileSplit, use the links below to complete the Application. Your application is automatically "approved" if it accepts your athlete's mark/time--and is complete once payment is received. Upon completion you will receive their All-American certificate and additional ways to recognize them through Maxwell Medals.
